Dear Parents and Friends,

A big hearty "thank you" goes out to all who attended and participated in Parent/Teacher Conferences. I would like to clear up several points and clarify expectations for your son or daughter's success at Lakeview:

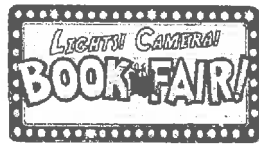
