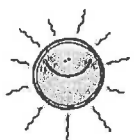

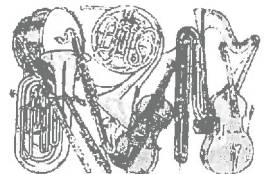
"BE KIND" Assemblies
