The performers of this year's Lakeview Talent Show have been busy perfecting their routines for the final performance on Tuesday, May 16 at 6:30 p.m.

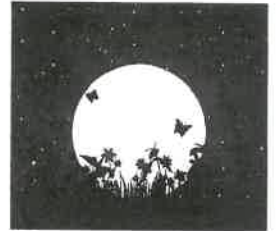
A special school-wide assembly will be held that morning at 9:00 a.m. in the cafeteria. You are welcome to come to both shows.

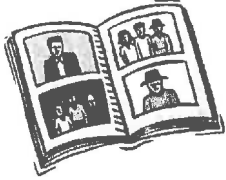

## 2017-2018 Registration

Registrations are being accepted now for incoming kindergarten-aged children who will turn 5 years old on or before August 31, 2017 and all new to Lakeview may register for the 2017-2018 school year by coming to the Welcome and Registration Center at 3200 W. Cholla. The center is open Monday through Friday 7:15 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., closed from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. on Wednesdays. Registration packets can be picked up there, at Lakeview or go online at [www.wesdschools.org](http://www.wesdschools.org) and click on the registration tab. Bring your child's birth certificate, proof of residence, immunization record and custody papers (if necessary.)

## Immunization Requirements

The following information is very important regarding immunization requirements for the 2017-2018 school year per Arizona School Immunization Law, Article 7, R9-6-701-708:

All students are required to show proof of chickenpox (varicella) immunization or to provide a signed history form stating that the student has had chickenpox.

For the 2017-2018 school year, Arizona School Immunization Law states that all students 11 years of age and older entering the sixth, seventh, and eighth grades must have one dose of Meningococcal vaccine (MV). These students are also required to have one dose of Tdap vaccination if five or more years have passed since their last tetanus/diphtheria vaccine dose.

If your child has received the required immunization, please provide the school with the documentation (shot records). The record must show the child's name, date of birth, date dose received, and physician/health agency that administered the immunization.
