Dear Parents and Friends,

Welcome to the 2017-2018 school year! We have started with a very hot and humid school year! I have seen many smiles, new faces and excited students ready for a great year!

In an ongoing effort to promote Lakeview's vision of "providing a school climate that allows every student the opportunity to grow and thrive," we are introducing a new school wide behavior system this year called PBIS.

PBIS stands for *Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports*. The philosophy of this program is that by acknowledging students for their positive behavior choices through tickets, praise, and rewards, students will begin to build an internal motivation to behave in a positive way. These positive behaviors will continue to build the positive learning environment we have here at Lakeview.

Our expectations for students and staff are our ROARS Expectations. They stand for:

- R**—Respect
- O**—On Task
- A**—Always Be Nice
- R**—Responsibility
- S**— Safe



Students demonstrating these expectations can receive a ROARS ticket. The student then puts his or her ticket in the classroom bin. On Fridays, two names from each grade level are pulled during the morning announcements. These winners will receive recognition on the announcements, a ROARS certificate, and can choose a prize from our ROARS Rewards Board.

Students have been learning about our ROARS expectations throughout school in every classroom.

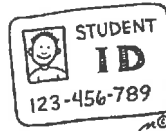
## Welcome! TO LAKEVIEW

## Student ID Cards

Each student at Lakeview should have received an ID card, coin sticker pass, and a pouch with a lanyard. The blue Lakeview ID card is for students to use in the library to check out books and to scan for lunch in the cafeteria. On Thursday, these cards became your son or daughter's permanent ID card when school pictures were taken.



The other plastic PVC coin-shaped card or Z-Pass with the numbers printed on it is used to track student bus riders as he or she boards and departs from a school bus.

It is important to know that safety is our top priority, and each student should wear his or her ID card and Z-Pass daily while on campus. These cards are very important, please keep it from being lost or stolen. There is a \$5 replacement fee for ID Cards or Z-Passes. Lanyards and pouches may be replaced, for 50 cents each.

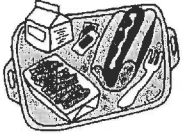

## Free Meals for Students



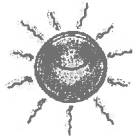

## Immunization Requirements

The following information is very important regarding immunization requirements for the 2017-2018 school year per Arizona School Immunization Law, Article 7, R9-6-701-708:

All students are required to show proof of chickenpox (varicella) immunization or to provide a signed history form stating that the student has had chickenpox.



For the 2017-2018 school year, Arizona School Immunization Law states that all students 11 years of age and older entering the sixth, seventh, and eighth grades must have one dose of Meningococcal vaccine (MV). These students are also required to have one dose of Tdap vaccination if five or more years have passed since their last tetanus/diphtheria vaccine dose.

If your child has received the required immunization, please provide the school with the documentation (shot records). The record must show the child's name, date of birth, date dose received, and physician/health agency that administered the immunization.
